Argument in Favor of Measure G

Perris is a family-oriented community that focuses on providing recreational opportunities for the youth of the City. City leaders are committed to looking for additional funding to provide parks and athletic fields for the residents of Perris.

Measure G is good for Perris. After careful consideration, the City Council placed Measure G on the ballot to seek voter approval to sell the City's sewer system.
