Auto Speedway Free for Perris Residents on July 4th

Residents of the City of Perris will be admitted free to Perris Auto Speedway when the popular Riverside County racing facility celebrates Independence Day this Friday, July 4th, with a night of sprint car racing and the biggest and best Fireworks show in Riverside County. Presented by the City of Perris and Budweiser, spectator gates will open at 3:00 p.m. and racing will start at 7:00. The fireworks extravaganza will take place around 9:00 p.m.
