Pink Skies Event this Weekend

The historic Santa Fe Depot is the site of Saturday's showing of the documentary "Pink Skies," which details the 2009 world-record parachute jump in Perris that raised nearly \$2 million for breast-cancer awareness and research.

The event takes place at 4:30 p.m. Saturday at the Depot at Fourth and D Streets in Downtown Perris and includes hors d'oeuvres and an evening showing of the film.

"Pink Skies" tells the story of the world's largest women-only parachute jump, which took place above the Perris Valley Skydiving center on Sept. 29, 2009. A total of 181 women from 31 countries took part in the record-setting skydive. The movie also introduces several skydivers who are battling the disease and who relate their personal battles with cancer.

Admission to the showing of "Pink Skies" is free.
