If any responsible person is a corporation and/or out-of are beneficiary/trustee/owner, a local property manager will be hired to perform weekl inspections to verify that the requirements of this chapter, and any other applicable laws are being met.
Pools and spas shall be kept in working orders so that water remains clear and free of pollutants and debris or drained and kept dry. In either case properties with pool and/or spas must comply with the minimum security fencing requirements of the State of California
Required maintenance includes but is not limited to regular watering, irrigation cutting, pruning and mowing of required landscape and removal of all trimmings.
Permitted landscaping does not include weeds, gravel, broken concrete, asphal decomposed granite, plastic sheeting, indoor-outdoor carpet or any similar material.
Permitted landscaping includes, but is not limited to, grass, ground cover, bushes shrubs, hedges or similar plantings, decorative rock or bark or artificial turf/sod designe specifically for residential installation.
Visible front and side yards shall be landscaped and maintained in accordance with city requirements and neighborhood standards
The property shall be kept free of graffiti, tagging or similar markings by remova or painting over with an exterior grade paint that matches the color of the exterior of the structure.
