

Placentia Avenue Widening Project

Purpose of the Project:

This City project will be widening Placentia Avenue from 2 to 6 lanes. This project is currently under construction and is scheduled to finish concurrently with the Placentia Interchange Project in September. This project will include the construction of sidewalk, bike lanes, streetlights, storm drain facilities, the addition of a Traffic Signal at the intersection of Indian Avenue and Placentia Avenue. This project will also include the widening of the Perris Boulevard and Placentia Avenue intersection to accommodate the additional lanes.

Funding:

This project is funded by Riverside County Transportation Commission Contributions, EMWD Contributions and RBBD Funds.

Why are the roads closed?

Due to the high volume of traffic and amount of work within Perris Boulevard, Placentia Avenue will be closed between Barrett Avenue and Perris Boulevard and Spokane Street and Perris Boulevard. To ease traffic queuing and avoid driver confusion Perris Boulevard will be reduced to one lane in each direction with the traffic signals set continuously on green. The road closures will minimize the overall amount of time needed to construct the facilities within Perris Boulevard and will keep both the Contractor and public safe during construction.

How long are the closures going to last?

The closures are anticipated to last six weeks.
