Art Mural Criteria

- Interested Artists must submit an application with desired proposed location(s) identified.
- Private locations must have an agreement in place between property owner and artist.
- Public locations must have City approval.
- All proposed art pieces must incorporate at least one of the Public Art Initiative art elements:

Artists interested in participating must submit a completed application and all entries must be original artwork. Submissions will be evaluated using the established selection criteria below:

- 1** Art Mural Program completed application
- 2** Proposed project artwork incorporating Perris art mural element(s)
- 3** Proposed project concept statement
- 4** Examples of artists previous work (4 or less)
- 5** Evidence of the value of proposed artwork
- 6** Project budget, maintenance plan and timeline
