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Argument in Favor of Measure A

Vote YES on A: help maintain our quality of life, improve city streets and keep Perris on the right track — without increasing taxes on local residents.

Our city continues to grow and thrive, but that growth has also meant more strain on our local streets and roads. The City has done all it can to keep our roads safe and maintained, but the increase in distribution facilities, warehouses, and industrial businesses has strained city public roads, impacting collector streets, arterial streets, and truck routes – and making it harder for residents to get around.
