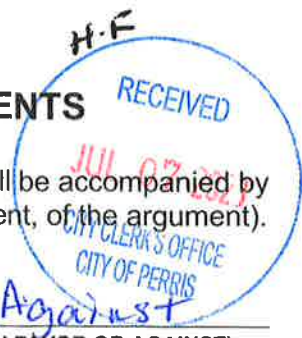

Rebuttal Argument in Favor of Measure A



The lone author of the argument against doesn't live in Perris, understand our community, or have his facts right.

Voting YES on Measure A ensures our streets and potholes get fixed without increasing taxes one cent on our residents.

Fact: Warehouse facilities pay a one-time fee to help with **new** roads and bridges, **not** ongoing maintenance, or costs to help keep our roads safe and in good driving condition.

Fact: Over the past 15 years the industrial growth to our area has created a lot of demand on and damage to our local roads.

Fact: Large trucks that service these warehouses contribute greatly to the potholes, cracks and our poor roads. While the City has been responsible making the most efficient use of limited resources, the ongoing strain to our roads is beyond available resources.

- Legally, funds may only be used to repair streets and roads in Perris and can't be taken by the state or federal governments
- Funds would be subject to annual general financial audits
