Measure A is a new \$120 million tax that targets Perris businesses and their employees, including those who live in our city. The tax hike will raise the costs of any goods distributed from these Perris businesses and will negatively impact hard-working families, small businesses and others in the City that buy these goods.

VOTE NO ON MEASURE A. It's a job-killing double-tax.

The City Council knows that whenever it approves a development project, warehouses pay to maintain and improve City infrastructure – roads, sidewalks, parks and other community projects. Developers also pay Road and Bridge District fees that fund road improvements in Perris. In fact, the City is sitting on over \$30 million of unspent RBD fees.
