RESOLUTION NUMBER 5723

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS ADJUSTING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE ELECTED CITY CLERK POSITION AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NUMBER 5383

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 36517 the City Council of the City of Perris has the authority to establish the compensation of the elected city clerk ("Clerk") by resolution; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution Number 5383, adopted by the City Council on October 30, 2018, the City Council established a monthly stipend of \$1,335 per month for the Clerk for the performance of statutory duties set forth in Perris Municipal Code Chapter 2.09; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to increase the Clerk's compensation to \$1,401.22 per month for the performance of statutory duties set forth in Perris Municipal Code Chapter 2.09.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** The Clerk shall receive the following compensation:
- A. <u>Stipend</u>. The Clerk shall be paid a stipend of One Thousand Four Hundred One Dollars and Twenty-two Cents (\$1,401.22) per month as compensation for an elected official performing the limited statutory duties set forth in Perris Municipal Code Chapter 2.09. The stipend shall be paid once a month, no later than the 30th of the month. If the Clerk is requested to perform the duties of an elections official as set forth in the Elections Code, the Clerk may be compensated at an hourly rate to be set by the City Council.
- **B.** <u>Benefits</u>. The Clerk shall be provided a vehicle allowance of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) per month, and shall be provided medical and retirement (PERS) benefits at a rate equivalent to the members of the City Council.
- **C.** Expenses. The Clerk shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of the Clerk's duties. Proof of such expenses in the form of receipts, etc., shall be provided to the City Manager, or his or her designee, before the City shall make a disbursement to the Clerk. Travel expenses shall require prior approval from the City Manager.
- **Section 2.** The compensation provided herein shall be effective as of December 1, 2020.
- **Section 3.** Resolution Number 5383 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.
