Application to Demolish Buildings 2022 CALIFORNIA BUILDING CODE

A permit is required to demolish any buildings on residential, commercial or industrial property located within the City of Perris. Please read the information below, prepare the requested drawings and complete this application prior to applying for this permit.

Submit two (2) copies of a site plan drawn to scale showing all the buildings and structures on the property. Indicate which building(s) are to be demolished and the height and square footage of each building. If applicable, indicate the location(s) of any septic tanks, sewer lines, leach fields and/or wells. Indicate how these systems will be abandoned and/or removed. Show the distance to pedestrian ways (sidewalk). If applicable, show the type and location of pedestrian protection as required by Section 3303.2 of the 2022 California Building Code. Prior to commencing work, a site inspection will need to be scheduled with the City of Perris (Building Division) to verify compliance of proposed pedestrian protections. An asbestos surveyor to determine if materials contain asbestos shall be completed - unless waived by Building Official.

If the building(s) being demolished are 50 years old or more, *prior to issuance of the demo permit*, a photograph of each side of the building will need to be submitted to the Planning Division for review and approval. For buildings listed in the General Plan Conservation Element as historic resources (*see attached Table CN-2: Historical Sites and Buildings*), an Environmental Assessment application will need to be submitted to the Planning Division for entitlement approval.
