How do I apply?

Step 1: Obtain the required Permits/Certificates from the County of Riverside Department of Environmental Health

Step 2: Obtain commercial General liability + Automotive liability insurance (*at no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence*) and name the City of Perris as an additional insured

Step 3: Apply for a City of Perris Business License with proof of completion of Step 1 and 2.

When can I operate/open?

- 7:00 am - 2:00 am
- This includes setup and clean-up
- No operations shall be conducted from 2:00am - 7:00am

Where can I park/operate?

- MUST be within a maintained and developed lot or public street that allows street parking
- Be 250 ft away from City approved Temporary Event
- Cannot block view for any vehicular or pedestrian traffic
- 1,000 ft away from a school between 6:30 am & 5:30 pm

Rules if parking on

Private Property:

- Minimum (2) off-street parking spaces for customers. Cannot be spaces currently being used by a operating business
- Recycle & Trash containers to collect trash in 100ft radius
- Written permission from property owner kept on vehicle at all times
- 200 sq ft maximum of seating area for patrons. Must not block traffic/parking or be in landscaping areas
- May not store the vehicle at this location when not in operation
- Possess all required certifications, permits, and other authorizations with the operator at all time

What can't I do?

- Idle the truck for longer than (5) minutes per ever hour
- No temporary lighting on the site except localized lights on truck
- No signage
- No sales of services or alcohol
- No loud music (cannot violate the noise ordinance)
- No discharge of liquids or solids into street or storm drain
- Cannot block view of traffic or pedestrians while parked
- Cannot block sidewalk at any time

Rules if parking along a curb within a public

street:

- Shall park directly adjacent to paved sidewalk in a legal parking area and must not obstruct pedestrian passage
- Recycle & Trash containers to collect trash in 100ft radius
- Service from truck can only be from the side facing the sidewalk
- Cannot encroach onto sidewalk with any part of vehicle, equipment, or furniture
- Cannot create reduction in sight distance for any pedestrian, bike, or vehicle traffic for any road, crosswalk, driveway
- Possess all required certifications, permits, and other authorizations with the operator at all time

Where can I store the truck?

- The truck may be stored in a FULLY enclosed garage out of the view of the public
- The truck may be stored in a licensed storage facility authorized to store Food trucks during non-operation
