## ORDINANCE NO. 1308

- AN ORDINANCE (OA 13-10-0011) OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, TO ADD PERRIS ZONING CODE CHAPTER 19.69.020 SECTION B 5, RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKING AND MAKING FINDINGS IN SUPPORT THEREOF.
- **WHEREAS**, Perris Municipal Code Chapter 19.69.020 Section B 5, establishes regulations and development standards for recreational vehicle parking placed within the City; and
- **WHEREAS**, the recreational vehicle parking section is intended serve the public and residents in the City by providing a variety of placement opportunities, and a clear approval process; and
- **WHEREAS**, Ordinance Amendment workshops were held with the Planning Commission on October 16, 2013 to review the current zoning code for revision; and
- **WHEREAS**, Ordinance Amendment 13-10-0011 includes revisions to one other zoning code section 19.08; and
- **WHEREAS**, this project required review by the Riverside County Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) for consistency with the two airport land use plans affecting the City of Perris, the March Air Reserve Base ALUP and the Perris Valley Airport Land Use Plan, and the project was deemed "Consistent" by ALUC on September 11, 2014; and
- **WHEREAS**, on October 1, 2014, the Planning Commission conducted a regularly scheduled and legally noticed public hearing for Ordinance Amendment 13-10-0011, and recommended approval of the project after considering public testimony and accompanying documents; and
- **WHEREAS**, on October 28, 2014, the City Council conducted a duly noticed public hearing introducing the first reading of an Ordinance to revise Section 19.69.020 Section B 5 of the Zoning Ordinance, Recreational Vehicle Parking (draft attached); and,
- WHEREAS, all legal prerequisites for the adoption of this Ordinance have occurred.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Perris, as follows:
  - **Section 1.** The above recitals are all true and correct.
- **Section 2.** The City Council has reviewed and considered the environmental information included in the Initial Study, which was the basis for the Negative Declaration. The

Negative Declaration states that the proposed project could not have a significant on the environment, and was prepared pursuant to the requirements of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

The Planning Commission further finds and determines that the City has complied with the California Environmental Quality Act and that this determination reflects the independent judgment of the City Council.

- **Section 3.** Based on the information contained within the staff report and the accompanying attachments and exhibits, the City Council hereby finds:
- A. The proposed Ordinance Amendment will not result in a significant adverse effect on the environment.
- B. The proposed Ordinance Amendment will not conflict with the goals, policies, and implementation measures set forth in the General Plan and Zoning Ordinances.
- C. The proposed Ordinance Amendment will not have a negative effect on public health, safety, or the general welfare of the community.
- **Section 4.** The City Council hereby adopts the second reading of the attached Ordinance to add Zoning Code Chapter 19.69.020 Section B 5, based on the information and findings presented.
- **Section 5.** The City Council declares that should any provision, section, paragraph, sentence, or word of this Ordinance be rendered or declared invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, or by reason of any preemptive legislation, the remaining provisions, sections, paragraphs, sentences and words of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- **Section 6.** The Mayor shall sign and the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance.
