

ORDINANCE NUMBER 971

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS AMENDING CHAPTER 19.77 OF THE PERRIS MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD OF ZONING ADJUSTMENT, SUBSTITUTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICES REPRESENTATIVE WITH A MEMBER FROM THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Perris (the "City Council") on September 14, 1992, adopted Ordinance Number 928 which created the Board of Zoning Adjustment; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance Number 928 set forth Section 19.77.010 of the Perris Municipal Code relating to the assignment of members to the Board of Zoning Adjustment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Zoning Adjustment will benefit from the inclusion of a representative from the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the designated staff members of the Board of Zoning Adjustment should include a representative from the Police Department in lieu of a representative of the Department of Public Services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Perris hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 19.77.010 of the Perris Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

Section 19.77.010 Establishment of Board of Zoning Adjustment.

There shall be established pursuant to the authority granted in Section 65900 of the California Government Code, a Board of Zoning Adjustment for the purposes of administering the provisions of this Chapter. The regular members of the Board of Zoning Adjustment shall consist of the Director of Planning and Community Development, representatives from the Building Inspections Division and the Police Department as determined by the City Manager, and two citizens as appointed by the City Council for a four year term, following an initial appointment of three and four year staggered terms. An alternate member of the Board of Zoning Adjustment shall be the next most senior official in the City

department headed by that member of his or her appointee. These alternates shall serve when the respective regular members are absent. The citizen members shall not have alternates. Any three Board members or alternates shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of conducting business. The Director of Planning and Community Development shall serve as the official secretary of the Board and shall make, keep and maintain all the records of the proceedings of the Board. All Board of Zoning Adjustment hearings shall be conducted as public hearings pursuant to Government Code Section 65090 et seq.

SECTION 2. The Mayor shall sign and the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published and posted pursuant to the provisions of law in this regard, and this Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage.
