

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 1000**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 2.04.020 OF THE PERRIS MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING ELECTION OF MAYOR AND MAYOR PRO TEMPORE AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 617**

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

*Section 1.* Section 2.04.020 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The Mayor and Mayor pro Tempore shall be Council persons and shall be elected by the Members of the City Council and they shall serve at the pleasure of the City Council. The election of Mayor and Mayor pro Tempore *may* be held each year at the first regular meeting of the City Council in the month of November, except that on election year it shall be held at its first meeting following receipt of Certificate to the Canvass of Election Returns."

*Section 2.* Ordinance Number 617 is hereby repealed.

*Section 3.* This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.
