## **ORDINANCE NUMBER 1002**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING COLLECTION CHARGES AS PERMITTED IN SECTION 7.16.050(D) OF THE PERRIS MUNICIPAL CODE AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 983

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 7.16.050(D) of the Perris Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- a. Monthly charges and rules and regulations for disposal service and collection, including non-residential collection, shall be fixed from time-to-time by ordinance of the City Council. Monthly charges established by ordinance of the City Council shall be a civil debt owing to the City by the owner and any occupant or user of the premises receiving service.
- b. The consumer price index increase for the last year was 1.4%.
- c. Said increases of tipping fees and the consumer price index make it necessary to defray these costs by increasing the rates and charges to the recipient of such services.
- Section 2. The new rates and charges for solid waste collection services are set forth on attached Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference are hereby adopted.
  - Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.
  - Section 4. Ordinance Number 983 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

## Exhibit "A"

Pursuant to 7.16.050(D) of the Perris Municipal Code, the rates and charges of Chapter 7.16 are adjusted as follows:

"Section 7.16.050 Collection and Disposal"

- 1. A monthly charge for rubbish collection and disposal services is hereby levied upon each occupied household and business establishment, in accordance with the following rates:
- (a) Residential
  - (1) Single family residences, mobile homes, apartments, condominiums, townhomes, bungalow courts, and multiple residences per dwelling unit, using 100 gallon individual receptacles.

Monthly Rate:

\$13.30

(2) Single family residences, mobile homes, apartments, condominiums, townhomes, bungalow courts, and multiple residences per dwelling unit, using 60 gallon individual receptacles.

Monthly Rate:

\$10.41

- (b) Commercial and Industrial
  - (1) Individual receptacles

Once per week pick up:

\$13.30

(c) Commercial, Industrial, and Multiple Residences
