ORDINANCE NUMBER 1036

AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ADJUSTING THE RATES FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Perris adjusts the solid waste collection and disposal service rates (the "Rates") to reflect any increase in the Consumer Price Index (the "CPI") and/or any increase in Landfill Tipping Fees; and

WHEREAS, in 1995 the CPI increased by 2.0%; and

WHEREAS, currently, the City is experiencing extreme financial hardship; and

WHEREAS, to continue to provide solid waste collection and disposal services within its jurisdiction, it is necessary for Perris to increase the Rates to reflect the CPI no later than July 1, 1996; and

WHEREAS, failure to provide solid waste collection and disposal services would result in an immediate threat to public health and safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Perris does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The rates for solid waste collection and disposal shall increase as set forth in Exhibit "A".

Section 2. It is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety that this Ordinance take effect immediately to protect public health and safety by continuing with refuse collection and disposal, to protect the economic viability of the community and to ensure that the character of the community is preserved. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an urgency measure and shall take effect immediately upon its adoption. The statement of facts constituting the basis for the urgency hereof is as above set forth.

Section 3. This ordinance shall expire upon the date that Ordinance Number 1037 becomes effective pursuant to State law.

Section 4. The rate increase shall go into effect on July 1, 1996.

Section 5. The Mayor shall sign and the City Clerk shall certifyto the passage and adoption of this ordinance and shall cause the same to be published and posted pursuant to the provisions of law in this regard, and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately and be in full force and effect until repealed by the City Council.
