

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1044

*AN ORDINANCE OF THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PERRIS,
COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA,
ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF MAYOR AS A POSITION
ELECTED BY THE ELECTORS*

WHEREAS, the General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Perris, California ("Perris") on Tuesday, November 7, 1995; and

WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and regularly given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; and that in all respects said election was held and conducted and the votes cast thereat received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in cities; and

WHEREAS, Measure D was submitted to the electors of Perris asking them if the Mayor of Perris shall be elected by the electors of Perris and serve a two-year term; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the qualified voters of Perris approved Measure D; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Number 2490 adopted November 28, 1995, the canvass of the voters of said election and has been certified by the Registrar of Voters, and the Clerk has presented the results to this City Council, said results are received, attached and made as part hereof as Exhibit "A."

NOW, THEREFORE, The People of the City of Perris do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That there shall be established the position of Mayor and Four City Council Members to be elected by the electors of Perris.

Section 2. The Mayor of Perris shall serve a two year term.
