RESOLUTION NUMBER 4586

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, IN SUPPORT OF A COMPREHENSIVE IMMIGRATION REFORM THERETO

- **WHEREAS**, City of Perris is one of the most diverse communities in America, with recent immigrants from more than 120 countries and foreign-born individuals comprising over 21.8 percent of the local population; and
- **WHEREAS**, the diversity of both the City of Perris and the United States keeps us strong and vibrant, and in an increasingly interconnected world, the diversity of our nation is a powerful advantage in global competition; and
- **WHEREAS**, our broken national immigration system undermines our core national and local interests; and
- **WHEREAS**, our laws should create an unburdensome and quick pathway to legal status that is fair, effective, and reflective of our values; and
- **WHEREAS**, a Pathway to Citizenship for members of the military, college graduates and other law-abiding immigrants, recognizes that reform is essential to protecting all workers; and
- **WHEREAS**, individuals who entered the United Sates as minor children did not knowingly violate any immigration laws and will have a separate "Path to Citizenship;" and
- **WHEREAS**, those who work in traditionally low, subsistence wage employment areas, including agriculture, hospitality and other service industries, deserve special consideration. Due to the importance of their work to the nation's food supply and general economy, these individuals should be allowed to earn a path to citizenship; and
- **WHEREAS**, other jurisdictions have adopted anti-immigrant policies that create distrust and divisiveness and divert scarce public resources, thus hindering government's delivery of essential services and the performance of its core functions, and
- **WHEREAS**, developing a comprehensive, functioning immigrations system is essential to ensuring America's future economic prosperity.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Perris, California, as follows:

Section 1. We call upon our federal representatives to support comprehensive and non-discriminatory immigration reform in Congress as put forward in the bipartisan measure proposed by Senators Rubio, McCain, Graham, Flake, Menendez, Schumer, Durbin and Bennet and President Obama.
