RESOLUTION NUMBER 4594

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS ADJUSTING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE ELECTED CITY CLERK POSITION AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NUMBER 4137

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 36517 the City Council of the City of Perris has the authority to establish the compensation of the elected city clerk ("Clerk") by resolution; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution Number 4137, adopted by the City Council on July 8, 2008, the City Council established a monthly stipend of \$1,400 per month for the Clerk, which compensated the Clerk for performing the statutory duties set forth in Perris Municipal Code Chapter 2.09 at that time; and

WHEREAS, on May 28, 2013, the City Council introduced an ordinance clarifying and reducing the limited duties of the Clerk, and has determined to reduce the stipend and other compensation of the Clerk accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** The Clerk shall receive the following compensation:
- **A.** <u>Stipend</u>. The Clerk shall be paid a stipend of eight hundred ninety dollars (\$890) per month as compensation for an elected official performing the limited statutory duties set forth in Perris Municipal Code Chapter 2.09. The stipend shall be paid once a month, no later than the 30th of the month. If the Clerk is requested to perform the duties of an elections official as set forth in the Elections Code, the Clerk may be compensated at an hourly rate to be set by the City Council.
- **B.** <u>Benefits</u>. The Clerk shall be provided a vehicle allowance of two hundred dollars (\$200) per month, and shall be provided medical and retirement (PERS) benefits at a rate equivalent to the members of the City Council.
- C. <u>Expenses</u>. The Clerk shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of the Clerk's duties. Proof of such expenses in the form of receipts, etc., shall be provided to the City Manager, or his or her designee, before the City shall make a disbursement to the Clerk. Travel expenses shall require prior approval from the City Manager.
- **Section 2.** The compensation provided herein shall be effective as of June 1, 2013.
- **Section 3.** Resolution Number 4137 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.
