A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AN ENVIRONMENTALLY PREFERABLE PURCHASES AND PRACTICES POLICY FOR THE CITY

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City of Perris to conserve and protect natural resources for current and future citizens; and

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989 (AB 939) mandates that local jurisdictions reduce the amount of waste being disposed of by 50 percent and that they participate in and promote waste reduction, reuse and recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Perris's participation in and promotion of recycling programs can significantly reduce the amount of material entering the waste stream, thereby conserving natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the City of Perris's commitment to the purchase of recycled materials will foster market development for recycled products; and

WHEREAS, the City of Perris, through the implementation of this policy, will serve as a model for private industry and local businesses; and

WHEREAS, this policy will further contribute to the City's compliance with State requirements that cities undertake and support recycled market development activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The foregoing statements are true and correct;
- 2. The attached Environmental Purchasing Policy is herby established as a procedure and guideline to be followed in the purchasing of goods and services by all City departments;
