

RESOLUTION NUMBER 4379

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA PASSING THROUGH INCREASES IN THE COST OF WATER CHARGED BY EASTERN MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT PURSUANT TO PERRIS MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 14.08

WHEREAS, Eastern Municipal Water District (“EMWD”) has adopted Resolutions and/or Ordinances increasing its water charges for water purchased by the City to supply to its customers, including imposing certain penalties related to conservation; and

WHEREAS, the City’s sole supply of water is provided by Eastern Municipal Water District, which necessitates the City adjusting the rates charged to its customers; and

WHEREAS, the City is permitted to pass through the EMWD increases to its customers pursuant to Municipal Code Section 14.08.060, adopted pursuant to Ordinance No. 1259 on July 14, 2009, and pursuant to Resolution No. 4244 adopted on July 14, 2009;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Perris, California, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That based on these facts and circumstances presented and the information received the City Council finds that increases in water rates are necessary and are hereby approved.

Section 3. Adjustments to Monthly Water Rates. Pursuant to Section 14.08.060 permitting changes in rates by Resolution, the water consumption rates set forth in Sections 14.08.020, 14.08.030, 14.08.040, 14.08.060, as said rates may have been adjusted pursuant to prior resolutions and/or ordinances, are increased as set forth below.

- A. Monthly Service Charge. There is no change to the flat monthly service charge based upon meter size for the City's Downtown Municipal Water System.
- B. Monthly Water Consumption Charge. The water consumption charge (as measured by the monthly meter reading based on the amount of hundred cubic feet of consumption ("hcf") shall be as follows with respect to meter size for all customers serviced by the City's Downtown Municipal System:

Customer Class/ Meter Size	Tier	Rates	Consumption Rates
5/8" - 1" Meters	Tier 1	\$2.407	0 to 18 hcf
	Tier 2	\$5.155	over 18 hcf
1.5" - 2" Meters	Tier 1	\$2.407	0 to 100 hcf
	Tier 2	\$5.155	over 100 hcf
3" - 4" Meters	Tier 1	\$2.407	0 to 300 hcf
	Tier 2	\$5.155	over 300 hcf
6" Meters	Tier 1	\$2.407	0 to 3600 hcf
	Tier 2	\$5.155	over 3600 hcf

Section 4. The revised rates and charges approved and established herein shall take effect on December 15, 2010. The City Clerk or other appropriate officer of the City is hereby directed to mail a notice describing the increases to customers and/or property owners at least 30 days prior to the effective date of the increase.

Section 5. All other provisions of rates pursuant to Chapter 14.08, as adjusted by Resolution or Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Any Resolution or portion thereof in conflict herewith relating to the increased water rates described herein is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and of no further effect to the extent of such conflict.

Section 7. The City Clerk shall certify as to the adoption of this Resolution.



Subject: Notification of Revised Wholesale Water Rates

Dear Mr. Belmudez:

We wish to advise you that Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) began paying nearly 8 percent more for all water that is purchased from MWD effective January 1, 2011. As a result of this action, EMWD proposes to revise its wholesale rates to reflect this increase which will affect all imported water purchased by your agency beginning March 1, 2011.

We intend to recommend this revision at the EMWD Board Meeting on January 19, 2011. The revision only passes on the MWD rate (no add on costs). The following recommended charges will be applied to your rates effective March 1, 2011:

- Treated Water = +\$43/af (from \$908 to \$951)

We are providing this information in advance, in order to keep you updated with these major changes and provide adequate time for your agency to incorporate these actions into your rate process.
