RESOLUTION NUMBER 4391

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, SUPPORTING WILDERNESS ADDITIONS IN NORTH SAN DIEGO COUNTY

WHEREAS, Congressman Issa has introduced the Beauty Mountain and Aqua Tibia Wilderness Act that will add 7,796 acres to the existing Agua Tibia Wilderness, expand Beauty Mountain Wilderness by 13,635 acres, and ensure a campground and trailhead is built outside Beauty Mountain Wilderness to improve recreational opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Forest Service and BLM administered wilderness and natural areas in North San Diego County are an important component of our community's historic, cultural, economic, and social identity, and generate substantial economic benefit for local area businesses through employment; tax revenues; visitor spending on meals, lodging, and supplies; and

WHEREAS, wilderness designation has been shown to increase tourism and attract new residents, thereby generating substantial economic benefits for nearby communities; and

WHEREAS, the proposed designation will contribute to our region's superior vistas, air quality, water quality, peaceful soundscapes, and dark night skies; and

WHEREAS, protected public lands will provide local residents and visitors with opportunities for many recreational activities including hiking, horseback riding, rock climbing, photography, camping, orienteering, wildlife viewing, scientific research, and nature study; and

WHEREAS, protecting wild places would ensure that future generations can enjoy them tomorrow as we do today.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the city of Perris endorses and supports the designation of wilderness as proposed in Congressman Issa's Beauty Mountain and Agua Tibia Wilderness Act.
