

RESOLUTION NUMBER 4287

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS SUPPORTING PASSAGE OF H.R. 1835 IN THE UNITED STATES HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND S 1408 IN THE UNITED STATES SENATE TO EXPAND USE OF ALTERNATE FUELS AND IMPROVE AIR QUALITY.

WHEREAS, Congressman Dan Boren introduced HR 1835 to the United States House of Representatives on April 1, 2009.

WHEREAS, Senator Robert Menendez introduced S 1408 to the United States Senate on July 8, 2009.

WHEREAS, supporting this Resolution will allow the City of Perris to demonstrate its continued support for improved air quality and decreased dependence on foreign oil.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Perris City Council has considered both the House and Senate bills (HR 1835 attached).

WHEREAS, under California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15000, the expression of support for HR 1835 and S 1408 is not subject to CEQA because there is no possibility of this action resulting in an adverse physical change to the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Perris City Council as follows:

Section 1. Incorporation of Recitals. The Recitals set forth above are true and correct.

Section 2. Environmental Review. The City Council hereby determines that expressing support for HR 2788 is not a “project” under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and is exempt from further environmental review, specifically finding that:

- A. The City has complied with the California Environmental Quality Act; and
- B. This determination reflects the independent judgment of the City.

Section 3. Approval and Findings. Based on the information contained within the Staff Report and the accompanying attachment, the City Council hereby approves this Resolution officially supporting passage of HR 1835 and S 1408, specifically finding that:

- A. The passage of these bills is consistent with General Plan objectives, policies and programs.

- B. The passage of these bills will not adversely affect the public health, safety and welfare.
- C. The passage of these bills will not adversely affect the environment.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its adoption.

Section 5. Remaining Provisions. The City Council declares that should any provision, section, paragraph, sentence, or word of this Resolution be rendered or declared invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, or by reason of any preemptive legislation, the remaining provisions, sections, paragraphs, sentences, and words of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Signatures. The Mayor shall sign this Resolution and the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution.
