NOW, *THEREFORE*, *BE IT RESOLVED* by the City Council of the City of Perris, that the records as listed in Attachment A may now be destroyed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that future requests for records destruction are hereby authorized in accordance with adopted guidelines, subject to approval and signature by the City Attorney.
