

RESOLUTION NUMBER 4279

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACTS OF THE CONSOLIDATED GENERAL UNIFORM DISTRICT ELECTION (CITY OF PERRIS SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION) HELD IN SAID CITY ON NOVEMBER 3, 2009, DECLARING THE RESULTS THEREOF AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Perris, California, on Tuesday, November 3, 2009, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and regularly given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects said election was held and conducted and the votes cast thereat, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Election Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Numbers 4228 and 4229 adopted on June 9, 2009 and Resolution Number 4239 adopted on June 30, 2009, the Riverside County of Registrar of Voters canvassed the returns of said election and has certified the results to this City Council, and said results are received, attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A";

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Perris does hereby **RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE** and **ORDER** as follows:

Section 1. That there were 13 voting precincts established for the purpose of holding said election consisting of consolidations of the regular election precincts in the City as established for the holding of state and county elections.

Section 2. That said special municipal election was consolidated with other elections being held in the same territory, with the same voters and held on the same date pursuant to Section 10400 of the Elections Code.

Section 3. That said special municipal election was held for the purpose of considering the following Measures of said City as required by laws relating to cities in the State of California, to wit:

Measure C – Perris 2009 Public Safety Tax Measure: shall the 2001-3 Community Facilities District tax be eliminated; and in order to preserve the safety and character in all neighborhoods in the City of Perris through general City services which may include fire protection, paramedic services, law enforcement, gang suppression, crime and drug intervention, local job creation and retention, and graffiti removal, shall a citywide parcel

tax be established?

Measure D – Priority for use of Perris 2009 Public Safety Tax Measure funds. Shall the Perris City Council make its top priority for use of parcel tax revenue fire protection, paramedic services, law enforcement, gang suppression, crime and drug intervention, local job creation and retention, and graffiti removal?

Measure E – Shall the position of City Clerk be appointive?

Section 4. That the whole number of votes cast in said City was 597. The whole number of vote by mail ballots cast in said City was 1314, making a total of 1,911 votes cast in said City.

That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the above named measures were as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

Section 5. The City Council does declare and determine that:

Measure C was rejected by the voters of Perris.

Measure D was approved by the voters of Perris.

Measure E was rejected by the voters of Perris.

Section 6. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of said City, a statement of result of said election showing:

The whole number of votes cast in the City;
The measures voted on in this election
The number of votes given at each precinct for
and against each measure.

Section 7. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution; shall enter the same in the book of original Resolutions of said City; and shall make a minute of passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceeding of the City Council of said City, in the minutes of the meeting at which the same is passed and adopted.
