

RESOLUTION NUMBER 4148

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, SETTING FORTH AN HOURLY RATE FOR ELECTION SERVICES PERFORMED BY THE ELECTED CITY CLERK

WHEREAS, pursuant to government Code Section 36517 the City Council of the City of Perris (“City Council”) has the authority to establish the compensation of the Elected City Clerk (“Clerk”) by resolution; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution Number 4137, adopted by the City Council on July 8, 2008, the City Council has the authority to set an hourly rate for duties performed by the City Clerk as set forth in the Elections Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to set such hourly rate as compensation for the performance of Election Services by the City Clerk during such time as the Deputy City Clerk is absent; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Perris, California that the hourly rate set for the performance of Election Services shall be as follows:

Section 1. The Clerk shall receive the following compensation:

A. Hourly Rate. The hourly rate shall be \$20.65 which represents the mid-line of the Deputy City Clerk’s hourly rate of pay, less the monthly stipend received by the City Clerk, which is currently \$1400.00 per month.

B. Automatic Adjustment. In the event that the hourly rate of the Deputy City Clerk is adjusted, the hourly rate set forth for Election Services compensation for the Elected City Clerk shall automatically adjust to the new rate.

C. Temporary Compensation. The hourly compensation set forth herein for performing Election Services is temporary and necessary during the time the Deputy City Clerk is absent and unable to perform such Election Services. The hourly compensation shall be paid for forty (40) hours per week commencing August 15, 2008 and terminating automatically on October 10, 2008 without further action by the City Council. The hours per week eligible for compensation shall be reduced by the number of hours worked that week by the Deputy City Clerk. [It is anticipated the Deputy City Clerk will work twenty (20) hours per week for a period of time before returning to work full-time].

The Mayor shall sign this Resolution and the City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this Resolution.
