## **RESOLUTION NUMBER 3626**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APPROVING NEGATIVE DECLARATION (2219) TENTATIVE PARCEL MAP 34082 (05-0334), AND DEVELOPMENT PLAN REVIEW 05-0335 FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF 27.32 ACRES INTO 21 LOTS AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF A 387,993 SQUARE FOOT MIXED USE BUSINESS PARK UNDER THE PLANNED DEVELOPMENT OVERLAY ZONE, AND MAKING FINDINGS IN SUPPORT THEREOF

WHEREAS, an initial study has been prepared for Tentative Parcel Map 34082 (05-0334) and Development Plan Review 05-0335, and based upon the environmental information staff finds that the projects could not have a significant effect on the environment because revisions in the project have been agreed to and made by the project proponent, therefore a Negative Declaration has been prepared; and

**WHEREAS**, this Tentative Parcel Map and Development Plan Review have been duly noticed; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 5, 2006, the Planning Commission conducted duly noticed public hearings on the proposed project, considered testimony and materials in the staff report and accompanying documents, and recommended approval of the proposed project; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 11, 2006, the City Council conducted a duly noticed public hearing on the proposed project, considered testimony and materials in the staff reports, accompanying documents and exhibits; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council considered and approved the Initial Study and Negative Declaration (2215) for the project, finding that these documents adequately addressed the impacts of the proposed project, were prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act, and reflected the independent judgment of the City; and,

**WHEREAS**, all legal prerequisites for the adoption of this resolution have occurred;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Perris, California, as follows:

- **Section 1.** The above recitals are all true and correct.
- **Section 2.** The City Council has reviewed and considered the environmental documentation for the project prior to taking action on the applications. Based on the analysis

contained in the Initial Study and the accompanying environmental information, the City Council finds that:

- A. There is no substantial evidence of potentially significant environmental impacts and a Negative Declaration (2215) has been prepared.
- B. The City has complied with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- C. Determinations of the Planning Commission reflect the independent judgment of the City.
- **Section 3.** Based on the information contained within the Project Report and the accompanying attachments and exhibits, the City Council hereby finds that:
  - A. The proposed project is consistent with General Plan objectives, policies and programs.
  - B. The proposed project will not adversely affect the public health, safety and welfare.
  - C. The proposed project will not aversely affect the environment.
- **Section 4.** The City Council hereby adopts Negative Declaration (2215) and approves Tentative Parcel Map 34082 (05-0334) and Development Plan Review 05-0335 based on the information and findings presented in the staff report dated April 11, 2006.
- **Section 5.** The City Council declares that should any provision, section, paragraph, sentence, or word of this Resolution be rendered or declared invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, or by reason of any preemptive legislation, the remaining provisions, sections, paragraphs, sentences and words of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.
- **Section 6.** The Mayor shall sign this resolution and the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution.
