

RESOLUTION NUMBER 3629

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF
CALIFORNIA, APPROVING NEGATIVE DECLARATION
2214 FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE EVANS ROAD
STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the proposed Evans Road street improvement project complies with the Circulation Elements of both City and County General Plans, and is necessary to improve traffic flow and alleviate existing flooding problems; and

WHEREAS, an initial study has been prepared for the proposed Evans Road street improvement project (P8-923), and based upon the environmental information, staff has determined that the project could not have a significant adverse effect on the environment; therefore, a Negative Declaration (2214) has been prepared;

WHEREAS, the proposed street improvement project has been duly noticed in a newspaper of general circulation and direct mailed to property owners within 300 feet of the site; and

WHEREAS, on May 9, 2006, the City Council considered all materials in the staff reports, accompanying documents and exhibits; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered and approved the Initial Study and Negative Declaration (2214), finding that these documents adequately addressed the impacts of the proposed project, were prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act, and reflected the independent judgment of the City; and

WHEREAS, all legal prerequisites for the adoption of this resolution have occurred;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Perris, as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are all true and correct.

Section 2. The City Council has reviewed and considered the environmental documentation for the project prior to taking action on the applications. Based on the analysis contained in the Initial Study and the accompanying environmental information, the City Council finds that:

- A. There is no substantial evidence of potentially significant environmental impacts and a Negative Declaration (2214) has been prepared.

- B. The City has complied with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- C. Determinations of the Planning Commission reflect the independent judgment of the City.

Section 3. Based on the information contained within the staff report and the accompanying attachments and exhibits, the City Council hereby finds that:

- A. The proposed project is consistent with General Plan objectives, policies and programs.
- B. The proposed project will not adversely affect the public health, safety and welfare.
- C. The proposed project will not adversely affect the environment.

Section 4. The City Council hereby adopts Negative Declaration (2214) and approves the Evans Road street improvement project (P8-923), based on the information and findings presented in the City Council Submittal dated May 9, 2006.

Section 5. The City Council declares that should any provision, section, paragraph, sentence or word of this Resolution be rendered or declared invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, or by reason of any preemptive legislation, the remaining provisions, sections, paragraphs, sentences and words of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. The Mayor shall sign this Resolution and the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution.
