## **RESOLUTION NUMBER 3362**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APPROVING MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION (2176) FOR THE RIDER STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT, ON RIDER STREET BETWEEN EVANS ROAD AND WILSON AVENUE, AND MAKING FINDINGS IN SUPPORT THEREOF

WHEREAS, the proposed Development Plan Review has been duly noticed; and

**WHEREAS**, an initial study has been prepared for Development Plan Review 04-0615 and based upon the environmental information staff found that the project could not have a significant impact on the environment as potentially significant environmental effects can be mitigated to less than significant levels, therefore a Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared.; and

*WHEREAS*, the CEQA documents were considered on January 25, 2005, at which time all interested persons were given full opportunity to be heard and to present evidence;

*NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED* by the City Council, City of Perris, California, as follows:

*Section 1.* The above recitals are all true and correct and incorporated herein.

*Section 2.* The City Council has reviewed and considered the environmental documentation for the project prior to taking action on the applications. Based on the analysis contained in the Initial Study and the accompanying environmental information, the City Council finds that:

- A. There is no substantial evidence of potentially significant environmental impacts and a Negative Declaration (2176) has been prepared.
- B. The City has complied with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- C. Determinations of the City Council reflect the independent judgment of the City.

*Section 3.* Based on the information contained within the Project Report and the accompanying attachments and exhibits, the City Council hereby finds that:

A. The proposed project is in accord with the objectives of this Title and the Purposes of the zone in which the site is located.

- B. The proposed project is consistent with the City's General Plan and conforms to all Specific Plans, zoning standards, and other ordinances and resolutions of the City.
- C. The proposed project will not be detrimental to the public health, safety or welfare, or materially injurious to properties or improvements in the vicinity.
- D. The proposed facility is in keeping with the development standards of the zone district within which it is proposed to be located and other applicable ordinances insofar as the location and appearance of the buildings and structures involved.

*Section 4.* The City Council hereby approves Mitigated Negative Declaration (2173), for Development Plan Review 04-0615, the Rider Street Bridge Replacement project, based on the information and findings presented in the City Council Submittal, dated January 25, 2005.

*Section 5.* The City Council declares that should any provision, section, paragraph, sentence, or word of this Resolution be rendered or declared invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, or by reason of any preemptive legislation, the remaining provisions, sections, paragraphs, sentences and words of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

*Section 6.* The Mayor shall sign this Resolution and the City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.
