## RESOLUTION NUMBER 3210

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS. COUNTY **OF** RIVERSIDE, **STATE** CALIFORNIA, ORDERING THE WORK IN CONNECTION WITH ANNEXATION OF TRACT 31114 TO BENEFIT ZONE **FLOOD** CONTROL *MAINTENANCE* DISTRICT NUMBER 1, GIVING FINAL APPROVAL OF THE ENGINEER'S REPORT AND LEVYING THE ASSESSMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004-2005

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Perris, County of Riverside, California ("the City Council") did on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2004, adopt the Resolution of Intention Number 3182 to order the therein described work in connection with the annexation and assessment procedures in the City of Perris Flood Control Maintenance District Number 1 (the "District"), and for which a Notice of Public Hearing was duly and legally published in the time, form and manner as required by law, shown by the Affidavit of Publication of said Notice on file in the office of the City Clerk; and

**WHEREAS**, after the adoption of Resolution of Intention Number 3182, a Notice of Public Hearing was duly posted in the time, form and manner as required by law, as appears from the Affidavit of Posting on file in the office of the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, after the adoption thereof, notice of the adoption of the Resolution of Intention, a Notice of Public Hearing and an Assessment Ballot were duly mailed to all persons owning real property proposed to be assessed for the improvements described in said Resolution of Intention Number 3182, according to the names and addresses of such owners as the same appears on the last equalized assessment roll for taxes of the County of Riverside or more recent information available to the City of Perris, which said documents were duly mailed in the time, form and manner as required by law, as appears from the Affidavit of Mailing on file in the office of the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, said City Council having duly received and considered evidence, oral and documentary, concerning the jurisdiction facts in this proceedings and concerning the necessity for the contemplated work and the benefits to be derived therefrom and said City Council having now acquired jurisdiction to order the proposed maintenance work; and

WHEREAS, said City Council has determined that a majority protest does not exist.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Perris as follows:

and

**Section 1.** That the public interest and convenience require the annexation to the district and levying assessments for maintenance and said City Council hereby orders that the work, as set forth and described in said Resolution of Intention Number 3182, be done and made.

## **Section 2.** Be it further resolved that:

- A. The Riverside County assigned fund number for the Flood Control Maintenance District No.1 and the annexation thereto is 68-2657.
- B. The assessments are in compliance with all laws pertaining to the levy of assessments in accordance with Section 53750 et seq. of the State of California Government Code.
- C. The assessments are in compliance with all laws pertaining toe the levy of assessments in accordance with Section 54703 et seq. of the State of California Government Code.
- D. The assessments are levied without regard to the property value.
- E. The purpose of the assessments is to provide flood control maintenance on those lands that will benefit the parcels being assessed.
- **Section 3.** That the report filed by the Engineer is hereby finally approved;

**Section 5. BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the method of assessment in the Engineer's Report is hereby approved and the assessments for Fiscal Year 2004-2005 are hereby levied.
