RESOLUTION NUMBER 3111

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING REGULATIONS FOR CANDIDATES FOR ELECTIVE OFFICE, PERTAINING TO MATERIALS SUBMITTED TO THE ELECTORATE AND THE COSTS THEREOF FOR THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN SAID CITY ON 4 NOVEMBER 2003

WHEREAS, Section 13307 of the Elections Code of the State of California provides that the governing body of any local agency adopt regulations pertaining to materials prepared by any candidate for a municipal election, including costs thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Perris, California, **DOES HEREBYRESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE** and **ORDER** as follows:

Section 1. General Provisions. That pursuant to Section 13307 of the Elections Code of the State of California each candidate for elective office to be voted for at the General Municipal Election to be held in the City of Perris on 4th November 2003, may prepare a candidate's statement on an appropriate form provided by the City Clerk. Such statement shall not include party affiliation of the candidate, nor membership or activity in partisan political organizations. Such statement shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk at the time the candidate's nomination papers are filed and withdrawn until 5:00 p.m. of the next working day after the close of the nomination period.

- **Section 2.** Spanish Language. The City Clerk shall send to each voter with the sample ballot, a voter's pamphlet that contains the statement of each candidate in English and Spanish for those candidates who have requested the translation pursuant to law. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of printing the candidates' statement in Spanish.
- **Section 3.** Payment. The City Clerk shall estimate the total cost of printing, handling, translating, and mailing the candidate's statement filed pursuant to the Elections Code, and request each candidate filing a statement to pay in advance his or her pro rata share as a condition of having his or her statement included in the voter's pamphlet. The City Clerk shall bill each candidate for any cost in excess of the deposit and shall refund any unused portion of any deposit.
- **Section 4.** That the City Clerk shall provide each candidate a copy of this Resolution at the time nominating petitions are issued.
- **Section 5.** No candidate will be permitted to include additional materials in the sample ballot package.

Section 6. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution; shall enter the same in the book of original Resolutions of said City; and shall make a minute of passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings of the City Council of said City in the minutes of the meeting at which the same is passed and adopted.
