## RESOLUTION NUMBER 2913

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APPOINTING THE CITY OF PERRIS CHIEF OF POLICE

**WHEREAS**, California Government Code Section 36505 requires that the City Council appoint the Chief of Police to manage the police department; and

**WHEREAS**, the office of Chief of Police for the City of Perris has been eliminated due to the City's contracting with the County of Riverside Sheriff's Department for the provision of police protection and law enforcement services; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Riverside Sheriff's Department has assigned Captain Guy Kestell to manage the Perris Station; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Perris is desirous of appointing Captain Guy Kestell as the Chief of Police of the City of Perris pursuant to California Government Code 36505.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Perris, California, as follows:

**Section 1**. The Captain assigned to the Perris Station of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department, Captain Guy Kestell, is appointed Chief of Police of the City of Perris.

**Section 2**. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
