

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2916

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, CALIFORNIA, EXTENDING THE INCREASED INFRASTRUCTURE FEE FOR FIRE SAFETY PENDING COMPLETION OF AN IMPACT STUDY

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2002, the City Council of the City of Perris (“City”) adopted Resolution Number 2908 as an urgency measure to provide a 30-day interim increase in the Fire safety component of the City’s Infrastructure Fee, pursuant to Government Code Section 66017(b); and

WHEREAS, on January 29, 2002, the City adopted Resolution Number 2909 extending the interim increase in the Infrastructure Fee for an additional 30 days pursuant to Government Code Section 66017(b); and

WHEREAS, the interim increase in the Infrastructure Fee will expire on March 7, 2002, unless extended for a second and final 30-day period pursuant to Government Code Section 66017(b); and

WHEREAS, the City is currently in the process of conducting an impact study to determine the appropriate level of fire safety impact fee reasonably required to meet the demands created by proposed new development projects, and the City Council has determined that a second 30-day extension of the interim increase is necessary to complete the study;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Extension of Fee Increase. The interim increase in the City’s Infrastructure Fee authorized by Resolution Number 2916 is hereby extended for the second and final 30-day period.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Resolution, and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portions thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences clauses, phrases or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 3. Certification. The City Clerk shall certify as to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and shall cause the same to be posted at the designated locations in the City of Perris.
