A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, ACTING IN ITS CAPACITY AS THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 2001-3 (NORTH PERRIS PUBLIC SAFETY) OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A SPECIAL ELECTION RELATING TO THE LEVY OF A SPECIAL TAX WITHIN SAID DISTRICT AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT

The City Council of the City of Perris, California (the "City Council"), in its capacity as the legislative body (the "Legislative Body") of the Community Facilities District No. 2001-3 (North Perris Public Safety) of the City of Perris (the "District"), does hereby resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, the Legislative Body called and duly held an election in the District pursuant to Resolution Number 2935 for the purpose of presenting to the qualified electors within the District, a proposition for the levy of a special tax within the District in accordance with the method set forth in Exhibit "A" to Resolution Number 2892 (the "Resolution of Formation"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Resolution Calling Election and the provisions of the Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982 (the "Act"), the special election was held on June 10, 2002; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Legislative Body a Certificate of the Election Official as to the Results of the Canvass of the Election Returns (the "Certificate of the Election Official"), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A";

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS DOES RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct.
- **Section 2.** The canvass of the votes cast in the District at the special election held in the District on June 10, 2002, as shown in the Certificate of the Election Official, is hereby approved and confirmed.
- **Section 3.** Proposition A-1 presented to the qualified electors for receipt by the Election Official on June 10, 2002, has received at least a two-thirds vote of the qualified electors owning not less than two-thirds of the property subject to the special taxes, voting at said election and Proposition A-1 has carried. The Legislative Body is hereby authorized to take the necessary steps to levy the special taxes authorized by Proposition A-1 on all non-exempt property within the District.

Section 4. The City Clerk is hereby directed to enter the title of this Resolution on the minutes of the Legislative Body and to indicate the official declaration of the result of such special election.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

Section 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
