

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 2962**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF PERRIS AUTHORIZING CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS AND EXPENDITURES ON THE BASIS OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2001-2002 BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002-2003, UNTIL THE ADOPTION OF THE 2002-2003 BUDGET**

**WHEREAS**, City staff have been in the process of preparing the City's budget for Fiscal Year 2002-2003, but the proposed budget was not completed for City Council consideration and adoption prior to the commencement of Fiscal Year 2002-2003; and

**WHEREAS**, to ensure the continued efficient operation of the City, the City Council desires to authorize continuing appropriations and expenditures for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 on the basis of the budget for Fiscal Year 2001-2002, until the City Council's adoption of the budget for Fiscal Year 2001-2003.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Perris as follows:

**Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

**Section 2.** The City Council hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager and his designees to take such actions as are necessary to continue appropriations and expenditures for Fiscal Year 2002-2003, for all necessary and continuing operations, on the basis of the budget, categories established, for Fiscal Year 2001-2002, on a proportionate basis, until the City Council's adoption of the budget for Fiscal Year 2002-2003.

**Section 3.** The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.
