

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2878

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF
CALIFORNIA APPROVING THE REDESIGNATION OF THE
RIVERSIDE COUNTY RECYCLING MARKET
DEVELOPMENT ZONE**

WHEREAS, the California Public Resources Code provides for the establishment of a Recycling Market Development Zone Program (RMDZ) throughout the State which provides incentives to stimulate development of post-consumer waste materials markets; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside, through its Economic Development Agency, has established a RMDZ and now desires to re-designate its RMDZ to include the City of Perris (“City”); and

WHEREAS, the City must meet certain reductions in landfill wastes, 25 percent by 1995 and 50 percent by 2000, as mandated in the California Integrated Waste Management Act; and

WHEREAS, the re-designation of the Riverside County RMDZ is essential for development of post-consumer waste materials markets and to assist the City in meeting landfill reduction goals; and

WHEREAS, the development of local markets for recycled materials in the City would reduce the need to transport them out of the region in the future; and

WHEREAS, the re-designation of the Riverside County RMDZ would provide incentives for business development, thereby enhancing the job creation and economic development goals of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Riverside County RMDZ has agreed to submit an application for re-designation to the California Integrated Waste Management Board to include the City; and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of the existing Riverside County RMDZ are set forth in a map on file with the Office of the Clerk of the Riverside County Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Perris as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

2. The City approves the submittal of the Riverside County RMDZ re-designation application.
3. The City supports the Riverside County Economic Development Agency to coordinate and process the proposed zone application.
4. The Riverside County Economic Development Agency will be the lead agency with respect to compliance with the California environmental Quality Act for actions undertaken with respect to the re-designation of the Riverside County RMDZ.
5. The re-designation of the Riverside County RMDZ is necessary to assist in attracting private sector recycling business investments to the area.
6. The current and proposed waste management practices and conditions in the City are favorable to the development of post-consumer waste materials markets.
