A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ADOPT A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING MARCH 2000 AS "UNITED STATES CENSUS MAKE YOURSELF COUNT MONTH"

*WHEREAS*, The City Council, City of Perris, support the Member Jurisdictions of Western Riverside Council of Governments in supporting an accurate and complete Census count; and

*WHEREAS*, the Census is a mechanism for allocation of federal funds and political representation; and

*WHEREAS*, participation in the Census by mail response is the most cost effective method of enumeration; and

*WHEREAS*, by focusing attention on Census participation, the City of Perris can decrease the potential undercount; and

*WHEREAS*, Census Month is an opportunity for government, industry, and community based organizations to recognize the potential of an accurate Census and to work together to encourage participation for a prosperous and sustainable future;

*NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS DOES RESOLVE,*

That the City Council of the City of Perris, State of California, in regular session assembled on February 29, 2000, does hereby proclaim that March 2000 is Census Month and urging all community members and businesses of Western Riverside County to participate in local and regional promotion and educational activities.
