A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE PERRIS POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN A MULTI-AGENCY TRAFFIC SAFETY/ENFORCEMENT GRANT

WHEREAS, the California Highway Patrol has received grant funds for the creation of a multi-agency Highway 74 Safety Task Force; and

WHEREAS, State Route 74 in Riverside County from the Orange County line to Interstate 215 has been identified as the corridor for which a Safety Action Plan is to be developed; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force has agreed that increasing law enforcement is an important element in improving traffic safety on the corridor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Perris that the Perris Police Department is authorized to participate in the grant and has authorized the City Manager to sign the participation agreement.
