

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2801

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING THE CITY ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING REVENUE OF THE CITY FOR THE 2000-2001 FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH Ordinance No. 250, the City Manager has prepared and submitted to the City Council a proposed budget for the 2000/2001 fiscal year Starting July 1, 2000, and

WHEREAS, the City Council as the legislative body of the City has reviewed and modified this budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is necessary for the efficient management of the City that certain sums of revenue of the City be appropriated to the various departments, offices, agencies and activities of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Perris, as follows:

Section 1. A certain document is on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Perris being marked and designated "City of Perris 2000/2001 Proposed Annual Budget". Said document as prepared by the City Manager, amended by the City Council and consisting of two copies, is hereby adopted for the Fiscal Year commencing July 1, 2000.

Section 2. The following sums of money are hereby appropriated from the revenue of the City of Perris for activities of the City, including transfers and capital projects during the 2000/2001 fiscal year:
