

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2756

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, RIVERSIDE COUNTY, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE GENERAL PLAN CIRCULATION ELEMENT (GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT 99-0171) APPROVING THE REALIGNMENT OF INDIAN AVENUE FROM MORGAN STREET TO CONNECT TO BARRETT AVENUE AT RAMONA EXPRESSWAY

WHEREAS, the applicant has requested an amendment to the Circulation Element of the General Plan adopted by the City Council on October 10, 1991; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment to the Circulation Element of the General Plan entails the realignment of an approximately one-half (1/2) mile segment of Indian Avenue (formerly Riverside Avenue) between Ramona Expressway (formerly Martin Street) south to Morgan Street, so that the realigned section curves to intersect Ramona Expressway at Barrett Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a duly noticed public hearing concerning amendment to the Circulation Element of the General Plan on November 9, 1999; and,

WHEREAS, an Initial Study and Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared in connection with Planning Case Number 99-0168 have been prepared, advertised, and circulated, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act; and,

WHEREAS, all legal prerequisites to the adoption of this Resolution have occurred;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Perris as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council has reviewed and considered the environmental documentation and information included in the staff reports prior to taking action on the application for the proposed amendment to the Circulation Element of the General Plan and finds and determines that the proposed realignment of Indian Avenue will not have a significant adverse effect on the environment because the mitigation measures described in the Initial Study will mitigate the impacts to less than significant, and that the Negative Declarations reflects the independent judgement of the City Council.

The City Council further finds and determines that there is no substantial evidence, in light of the whole record before the City, and the Project, as revised, would have a significant effect on the environment. The documents and other materials which constitute the record of proceedings upon which the City's findings and decision are based are located at

the Department of Planning and Community Development, 101 North D Street, Perris, California 92570. The custodian of these documents and materials is the Director of Planning and Community Development.

SECTION 2. The City Council has adopted Negative Declaration Number 2088 and the Mitigation Monitoring Plan, addressing the potential environmental impacts of the proposed realignment of Indian Avenue.

SECTION 3. The City Council hereby finds the amendments to the Circulation Element of the General Plan and the realignment of Indian Avenue are consistent with the goals and policies of the General Plan in that the proposed change in the Circulation Element will allow for the accommodation of regional transportation goals in accordance with General Plan Policy 1.1: "Develop a circulation system of city streets, excluding freeway, that is capable of serving existing traffic and expected future increases in traffic."

SECTION 4. The City Council of the City of Perris hereby amends the General Plan Circulation Element as identified in Exhibit A.

SECTION 5. The City Council declares that, should any provision, section, paragraph, sentence, or word of this Resolution be rendered or declared invalid by any final court action in a court of competent jurisdiction, or by reason of any preemptive legislation, the remaining provisions, sections, paragraphs, sentences, and words of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. The Mayor shall sign, and the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution.
