

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2758

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PERRIS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA ADOPTING AN ANNUAL FIRE/LIFE SAFETY INSPECTION FEE

WHEREAS, the purpose is to provide for the consolidation of certain schedules of fees related to the matters as provided for in the ordinance, resolutions and rules of the City of Perris.

WHEREAS, the meaning of any particular word or phrase appearing herein shall be determined by reference to the city ordinances, resolution, or rule to which it relates.

WHEREAS, should any fee provided herein be ruled invalid or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of all remaining fee provisions, processing the work on any application as required by code, ordinance or state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE City Council of the City of Perris as follows:

SECTION 1: The following fee's are hereby established by Resolution Number 2758 in providing and performing related services and matters an annual fire and life safety inspection to correlate with the renewal of City Business License. The fire safety inspection will be implemented on an annual program for all buildings and city businesses, other than single family dwellings, and shall be paid to the City of Perris Building and Finance Departments.

SECTION 2: Inspection fee set forth in the following table.

GROUP OR DIVISION	FEE AMOUNT	DESCRIPTION OF OCCUPANCY
A-1	141.00	A building or portion of a building having an assembly room with an occupant load of 1,000 or more and a legitimate stage.
A-2	117.50	A building or portion of a building having an assembly room with an occupant load of less than 1,000 and a legitimate stage.
A-2.1	117.50	A building or portion of a building having an assembly room with an occupant load of 300 or more without a legitimate stage, including such buildings used for educational purposes and not classed as a Group E or Group B Occupancy.
A-3	117.50	Any building or portion of a building having an assembly room with an occupant load of less than 300 without a legitimate stage, including such

		buildings used for educational purposes and not classed as a Group E or Group B Occupancy.
A-4	94.00	Stadiums, reviewing stands and amusement park structures not included within other Group Occupancies.
B	47.00	A building or structure, or a portion thereof, for office, professional or service-type transactions, including storage of records and accounts; eating and drinking establishments with an occupant load of less than 50.
E-1	94.00	Any building used for educational purposes through the 12 <sup>th</sup> grade by 50 or more persons for more than 12 hours per week or four hours in any one-day.
E-2	94.00	Any building used for educational purposes through the 12 <sup>th</sup> grade by less than 50 persons for more than 12 hours per week or four hours in any one-day.
E-3	47.00	Any building or portion thereof used for day-care or care of elderly purposes for more than six persons.
F-1	141.00	Moderate-hazard factory and industrial occupancies include factory and industrial uses not classified as Group F, Division 2 Occupancies.
F-2	117.50	Low-hazard factory and industrial occupancies include facilities producing noncombustible or nonexplosive materials that during finishing, packing or processing does not involve a significant fire hazard.
H-1	188.00	Occupancies with a quantity of material in the building in excess of those listed in Table 3-D that present a high explosion hazard as listed in Section 307.1.1.
H-2	188.00	Occupancies with a quantity of material in the building in excess of those listed in Table 3-D that present a moderate explosion hazard or a hazard from accelerated burning as listed in Section 307.1.1
H-3	188.00	Occupancies with a quantity of material in the building in excess of those listed in Table 3-D that present a high fire or physical hazard as listed in Section 307.1.1
H-4	141.00	Repair garages not classified as Group S, Division 3 Occupancies.
H-5	141.00	Aircraft repair hangars not classified as Group S, Division 5 Occupancies and heliports.
H-6	188.00	Semiconductor fabrication facilities and comparable research and development areas when the facilities in which hazardous production materials are used, and the aggregate quantity of material is in excess of those listed in Table 3-D or 3-E.
H-7	188.00	Occupancies having quantities of materials in excess of those listed in Table 3-E that are health hazards as listed in Section 307.1.1 U.B.C.
I-1.1	141.00	Nurseries for the full-time care of children under the age of six (each accommodating more than five children), hospitals, sanitariums, nursing homes with nonambulatory patients and similar buildings (each accommodating more than five patients).
I-1.2	141.00	Health-care centers for ambulatory patients receiving outpatient medical care, which may render the patient incapable of unassisted self-preservation (each tenant space accommodating more than five such patients).
I-2	141.00	Nursing homes for ambulatory patients homes for children six years of age or over (each accommodating more than five people).
I-3	188.00	Mental hospitals, mental sanitariums, jails, prison, reformatories and buildings where personal liberties of inmates are similarly restrained.
M	47.00	A building or structure, or a portion thereof, for the display and sale of merchandise, and involving stocks of goods, wares or merchandise, incidental to such purposes and accessible to the public.
R-1	47.00	Hotels and apartment houses, congregate residences.
S-1	94.00	Moderate hazard storage occupancies including buildings or portions of buildings used for storage of combustible materials not classified as Group S, Division 2 or Group H Occupancies.

S-2	47.00	Low-hazard storage occupancies including buildings or portions of buildings used for storage of noncombustible materials.
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S-3	47.00	Repair garages where work is limited to exchange of parts and maintenance not requiring open flame or welding, and parking garages not classified as Group S, Division 4 Occupancies.
S-4	47.00	Open parking garages.
S-5	94.00	Aircraft hangars and helistops.
