Proclamation Issued in Support of Mental Health Awareness Month

Accepting the Proclamation was April Jones, who serves on the Riverside County Behavioral Health Commission. California recognizes Mental Health Awareness Month every May.

About 12 million Americans are affected with mental-health challenges including depression, bipolar disorder and schizophrenia—conditions that can stigmatize those victims and discourage them from getting necessary and available help.
